The System of Equivalency of Private Schools

Article 5: American Curricula

1	The Student must pass successfully in Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 the minimum subjects of each stage, which shall be 5 subjects at least. And the minimum grades for passing not be lower than D or 60% in each subject. Islamic Education and Arabic Language are not included in these subjects.
2.	Students shall be granted the secondary education certificate with minimum grades of D or 60%.
3.	The Students shall choose the subject stated for studying from subjects included in Appendix 1

The System of Equivalency of Private Schools: National Emirati Students

The Country citizens' students (Nationals) shall pass:

a)	EmSAT Achieve:	English with a minimum grade of at least 1100 Grades
b)	EmSAT Achieve:	Math with a minimum grade of at least 500 grades

The System of Equivalency of Private Schools: Non-National / Expat Students

The Non-citizen/expats students shall pass

Non-citizen or expat students have a choice between completing the EmSAT examinations if they can **choose** to complete international examinations as mentioned below:

a)	English (Only complete one)	I. EmSAT - English with a minimum grade of at least 1100 Grades / II. IELTS Academic with a minimum grade of at least 5.0 Grades/ III. TOEFL English with a minimum grade of at least 61 grades in the online test for students (iBT)
b)	Mathematics (Only complete one)	I. EmSAT - Math with a minimum grade of at least 500 grades II. SAT 1 – Math Reasoning Test with a minimum grade of at least 450 Grades



The Grading System

FIS grading system depends on a 4 point scale. The passing average is 60 and the failing is 59. keep in mind that some universities don't accept marks below 65.

Your **grade point average (GPA)** is the sum of all your course grades throughout your **high school** career divided by the total number of credits. Most **high schools** (and colleges) report grades on a 4.0 scale.
